

B. Data from Family Record Book written by Samuel Ward's own hand:

FAMILY RECORD

Robert Ward, son of Samuel and Elizabeth Ward, was born Sept. 16, 1798, at Matlock, Derbyshire. Hannah Ward, wife of the above, daughter of Samuel and Elen Bowler of Darby, was born Sept. 10, 1804. Hariot Ward, daughter of the above Robert and Hannah Ward, was born June 12, 1826 at Darby. Emma Ward was born Nov. 28, 1827, at Matlock Bank. Samuel Ward was born Sept. 4, 1829, Matlock. Eliza Ward was born October 10, 1831 Matlock. The above contains the whole of family of the aforesaid Robert and Hannah Ward, Matlock Derbyshire, England.

Robert Ward died of consumption Feb. 4, 1844, aged 46 and (?) Matlock Bank Derbyshire, England. Emma Ward, daughter of the above, died (not finished). Mary Ward, daughter of Samuel and Ann Ward, died August 31, 1860, aged 10 months, 2 days, 14 hours. Samuel Ward, son of Robert and Hannah was married to Ann Bunting, daughter of James and Ann Bunting of Tansley Matlock, August 5, 1855. Samuel Ward was baptized in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints by priest Thomas Pointo(n) Oct. 1849. Confirmed by Elder (left out) Chesterfield Branch Sheffield conference.

Samuel Ward born Sept. 4, (1829) definitely, at Matlock Bank Derby Shire, England. Ann Bunting, wife of the above S. Ward, was born June 6, 1837, at Tansley Matlock Derby Shire, England. Emma Elen Ward, daughter of the above S. & A. Ward, born Sept. 27, 1857, on Tslandershill Schuykill C. Pa. U S A forty five minits past four am. Mary Ward was born Oct. 29, 1859, at Plainsville, Hamilton Co., Ohio. Eliza Ward born Sep. 16, 1861 12 p.m. 16 ward S L City. Alma Ward born March 17, 1863 Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah. William Ward born Feb. 7, 1864 Kaysville. Samuel Ward born May 21, 1866, Kaysville. Ann Ward born Feb. 22, 1868, Kaysville. James Bunting Ward born Dec. 10, 1869, Kaysville. Robert Ward born Dec. 8, 1871, Kaysville. Hannah Ward born Sept. 12, 1873, Kaysville.

Mary Ward died August 31, 1860, aged 10 months, 2 days, 14 hours at Council Bluffs, Iowa. Alma Ward died April 7, 1863, aged 21 days. James Bunting Ward died Aug. 19, 1871, aged 1 year, 8 months, 8 days, Kaysville. Ann Ward died Jan. 25, 1875, aged 37 years, 7 months, 21 days. (From here on hand writing changes).

William Ward died June 11, 1878 (or 1872) of diphtheria, aged 14 years, 4 months, 4 days at Kaysville. Samuel Ward died June 19, 1878, aged 12 of the same in Kays. Both were ordained Elders in the Church of Latter Day Saints. Samuel Ward, father of Robert Ward, died April 21, 1894.

(On a separate paper in record book) Not his handwriting:

Samuel Ward married to Catherine Norman Kirkland, April 10, 1879, in Salt Lake, Utah, By Danial H. Wells in the endowment house. She was born April 10, 1849, in the Parish of Abbott's Langley Hertford County, England. She had been married before to J. Kirkland and had 3 children. Names of children: James K. Ward, born Nov. 12, 1871, 10:40 a.m. District of Saint Giles, Edinburgh, Scotland. John William K. Ward, born Oct. 24, 1873, in the District Saint Peter, Duntee, Scotland, 5:40 a.m. Henry M. K. Ward, born April 24, 4 a.m., 1875, District Saint Peter, Dundee, Scotland.

Sarah Harriot Ward born May 31, 4 p.m., Kaysville, Utah, Davis County. George Ward born Sep. 12, 7 p.m. Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah. Samuel Norman Ward born March 29, 9 p.m., Kaysville. Simeon Thomas Ward, born January 6, morning, half past 7, Sunday, Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah. Charles Heber Ward, born Jan. 16, Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah. C. Story told by Mary Ward (wife of Samuel's son, Robert).

Samuel and Ann Bunting Ward were both born in England, Samuel Sept. 4, 1829, and Ann, June 6, 1837. They were married in England and came to America for the sake of the gospel. Two brother-in-laws and their wives came at the same time: Samuel Aston and William Young. Samuel worked in the coal mines in Penn. when they first came to America, and later made matches and wooden pegs for shoes out of maple. He pushed a hand-cart across the plains and while crossing them, they lost one baby. His sister, Mary Ashton, pulled a hand-cart across the plains and helped 3 children and their father. When they got to Salt Lake, they were married in the Endowment House. They lived in Morgan some and then in Kaysville where they had the rest of their family. They had 10 children: Emma Ellen (1857 Penn. 1934); Mary (1859 Ohio 1860); Eliza (1861 Salt Lake 1922); Alma (1863 Kaysville 1863) William 1864-1878); Samuel (1866-1878); Ann (1868); James (1869-1871); Robert (1871-1947) and Hannah (1873-). Five died as children.

They were very poor. Once Samuel walked from Morgan,

through Weber Canyon, to Salt Lake, bought an ax, a sack of flour, and enough factory to make two diapers for a baby that was soon to come, and walked all the way back. The babies had only a minimum of clothes and as one diaper was being used, they would wrap the other around the stove pipe to dry. In Kaysville they lived in a dirt roofed log house below the ditch from the Day house on the Mountain Road. Robert was born in a long log house and the day he was born there were two pigs hanging in the middle of the room.

Indians used to go along the first bench above their place and Samuel used to feed them and give them a place to stay. When he gave them slices of beef they hung it over a fire on a stick and cooked it. He also gave them dried fruit and meat. Once some of them stopped while an Indian women went alone somewhere to have a baby. As soon as it was born they went on.

Samuel had very little schooling but he was a very good writer. He was the first brick maker in Kaysville.

In 1875, Ann died of pneumonia and Samuel later married Catherine Norman, a widow with three children, and was sealed to her. They had 7 children, Sarah Harriot, George, Norman Samuel, Norman, Simeon Thomas, Charles Heber, and Cathrine. They lived in what is now the Day house.

D. Story written by Lucretia Slack. (Daughter of Robert Ward):

Samuel Ward, son of Robert Ward and Hannah Bowler, was born the 4th of Sept., 1829, at Matlock Derbyshire, England. He was baptized into the Chruch of Jesus Christ of Latter-day-Saints by Priest, Thomas Pointon in Oct., 1848, at Chesterfield Branch, Sheffield Conference. He was married to Ann Bunting at Matlock Derbyshire, England, Aug. 5, 1855.

Came to America on the ship Emerald Isle. He left England the 29th of November and landed in New York the 30th of December, 1855. Was on the water one month and one day.

He settled first at Flander Hill, Schykill Co., Penn., where he worked in the coal mine. Their first child, a little girl, Emma Ellen, was born here 27 Sept., 1857. From Flanders Hill they moved to Plainsville, Hamilton Co., Ohio, where he worked in an iron mine. On the 29th of October, 1859, another baby girl (Mary) was born at Plainsville, Ohio.

In the spring of 1860 they started their journey across the

plains to Salt Lake City. The baby, Mary, died while coming across the plains at Council Bluffs, Iowa, 31 Aug., 1860 .

After arriving in Salt Lake City they lived there one year. Then they moved to Kaysville on the Mountain Road (now called Fruit Heights) where he lived the rest of his life. Their third child, Eliza, was born in S.L.C. Altogether to this union there were born 10 children—5 boys and 5 girls. The ones born at Kaysville were Alma, William, Samuel, Ann Bunting, James Bunting, Robert and Hannah.

He helped build the old Salt Lake theater. (Brigham Young in charge).

When he first came to Utah he made wooden pegs to put soles on shoes. He also made matches. He was the first man to make bricks in Davis Co. He continued this occupation until his death. His son, Robert, ran the brickyard after his father's death.

Samuel Ward was a faithful Latter-Day-Saint. He and his family walked 3 miles to church every Sunday in all kinds of weather. He was sealed to his wife for time and eternity in the old Endowment House in Salt Lake City on 12 July, 1862.

They had sorrows when their baby died on the plains, and little Alma died when he was one month old; then James when he was 19 months old, but tragedy really struck his family in the spring of 1879. They had diphtheria and two boys . . . William, age 15, and Samuel, aged 13, died just 8 days apart.

They also had happy days. They always looked forward to the celebrations on the 4th and 24th of July.

Samuel was very good to the Indians who used to pass by his home. He told some Indians they could have the peaches off a certain tree, so for years when the peaches were ripe, along came the Indians for their peaches. They would unbutton their buckskin shirts and fill them, then button up again and ride off with their shirts full of peaches.

Samuel Ward's wife, Ann, died 25 Jan. 1875, at Kaysville, Utah. He married again 10 April, 1879, to Catherine Norman. To this union was born 7 children—2 girls and 5 boys, Sarah Harriot, George, Norman, Samuel Norman, Simion Thomas, Charles Heber, and Catherine.

Catherine Norman had been married before and had 3 boys

by her first marriage. Samuel Ward died 20 April, 1894, at Kaysville, Davis Co., Utah. He is buried in Kaysville cemetery.
